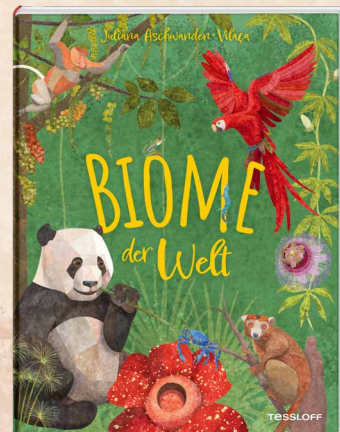
TOUCHING AND BEAUTIFUL!
